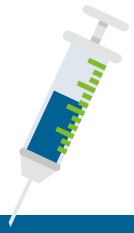

Who gives the shots?

Certified medical professionals (nurses and medical assistants) will come to your worksite at a day and time that is convenient for you.

How is payment handled?

We bill Medicare, PPO insurances and employers or accept private pay.

When will clinics be available?

Standard seasonal flu vaccinations will begin in September when the vaccine becomes available and will continue throughout the influenza season. All other vaccine clinics are scheduled over the course of the year.

Do you offer any other services?

Pneumonia and shingles vaccines, TB testing and other mobile nursing services are also available.
